



## DIRECTIONS TO THE HISTORIC DISTRICT FROM TYBEE ISLAND

- From Tybee Island take **Hwy 80 West** toward Savannah.
- Just before you reach the Hwy 80 overpass, approximately 8 miles from Tybee, bear to your **RIGHT** onto **Islands Expressway** (do NOT stay on Hwy 80).
- Go about 5 miles (**Islands Expressway** turns into **President Street**), under the Truman Parkway and to your next **RIGHT**, **Gen. McIntosh Blvd.**
- **Gen McIntosh Blvd.** bears to the **RIGHT** and takes you to **Bay Street**, the northernmost thoroughfare in the Historic District.

River Street is actually the northern boundary of the district, but it is a one-way street running eastbound along the riverfront. River Street is also the main tourist area where original riverfront warehouses have been converted into restaurants and shops and where most outdoor Holiday events are held.

The Historic District is roughly bounded by River Street on the north, Martin Luther King Blvd. on the west, E. Broad Street on the east and Gaston Street on the south. We highly recommend taking a Trolley Tour of Savannah where knowledgeable guides take you to the main points of interest as well as giving you some of the history of Georgia's oldest city.

Parking in the Historic District can be a challenge, but there is metered parking on most streets and several public-parking buildings, including one parking lot on River Street, and a large lot at the Savannah Visitors Center on Martin Luther King Blvd. just south of Oglethorpe Avenue.
